

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

Rebates began on March 15, 2010 and ended on August 17, 2010 when funding ran out. Rebate levels that took effect on June 23, 2010 will be awarded to all consumers who applied for rebates. HOW TO APPLY

Rebates were issued to consumers who mailed an application packet that included proof of purchase of an eligible product and documentation from either a participating retailer that the replaced unit was hauled away or from a recycling center that the replaced unit was received. Rebate applications must be submitted within 30 days of purchase. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebates are not retroactive.

ELIGIBILITY

Purchased appliances must be installed within an Arkansas residence. Qualifying units must be listed on the ENERGY STAR Web site, www.energystar.gov. Purchased appliances must replace an equivalent unit. Limit one rebate per appliance category per household.
