

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.



## CALIFORNIA

### REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED; WAITLIST ONLY

Rebates for room air conditioners, clothes washers, and refrigerators began on April 22, 2010. Rebates for dishwashers, freezers, electric heat pump water heaters, gas storage water heaters, solar water heaters, central air conditioners, air-source heat pumps, gas furnaces, and gas boilers began on July 29, 2010. On December 6, 2010, all rebate funds for dishwashers, freezers, refrigerators, clothes washers, and room air conditioners were reserved. No rebate applications for these products post-marked after December 6, 2010 were accepted. As of December 31, 2010, all rebates for central air conditioners, gas furnaces, gas boilers, heat pumps, and water heaters have been reserved; however, consumers can join a waitlist in the event that additional funding becomes available. ### HOW TO APPLY

Consumers must submit an application packet along with a completed rebate claim form, proof of recycling, and proof of purchase. Consumers must submit a completed rebate application within 120 days of the date of purchase that includes proof of residency, purchase and recycling. Rebate applications for dishwashers, freezers, refrigerators, clothes washers, and room air conditioners post-marked after December 6, 2010 will not be accepted. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis. Purchased products must be on the registered product list maintained at [www.cash4appliances.org](http://www.cash4appliances.org).

### ELIGIBILITY

Purchaser must be a California residential consumer. Consumer must replace an appliance in working condition. Replaced appliance must be taken off grid and recycled in accordance with program guidelines and applicable laws. Purchase must be made from a participating California retailer during the rebate offer period. Limit one rebate per appliance category per household.
