

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE

Rebates for dishwashers, room air conditioners, and water heaters began December 1, 2009. Rebates for refrigerators, freezers and clothes washers began January 15, 2010. Rebates for refrigerators and freezers closed on January 31, 2010. Rebates may be offered for a limited time only. HOW TO APPLY

Consumers can obtain application forms by visiting the program Web site or from participating retailers. Completed applications must be mailed with proof of purchase. Rebates will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebates will be issued to consumers as prepaid American Express® cards 6 to 8 weeks after receipt of complete application packet.

ELIGIBILITY

All Delaware residents are eligible. Consumers must be replacing an existing appliance to qualify for rebates. Rebates will be limited to two per appliance, per mailing address. Purchases must be made from a Delaware retailer or online retailer. The State of Delaware reserves the right to inspect the participants' property to ensure that equipment was installed at the address given.
