

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED

This program closed on December 1, 2010. Previously, rebates for dishwashers, room air conditioners, and water heaters began December 1, 2009. Rebates for refrigerators, freezers and clothes washers began January 15, 2010. Rebates for refrigerators and freezers closed on January 31, 2010. Purchases of room air conditioners, clothes washers, dishwashers, and water heaters needed to be made by August 31, 2010 to be eligible for rebates. Rebates for central air conditioners, gas and oil furnaces, air-source heat pumps, and gas and oil boilers began on July 21, 2010 and ended on December 1, 2010. HOW TO APPLY

Installation must be performed by an approved program contractor. A list of approved contractors is on the program Web site at www.energizedelaware.org/residential/efficiency-plus-program/heating-and-cooling-program. Please see Web site for a list of eligible equipment. Contractors will apply for rebates on behalf of customers and will obtain the necessary supporting documentation and proof of purchase from the customer. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.

ELIGIBILITY

All Delaware residents are eligible. Consumers must be replacing an existing appliance to qualify for rebates. Rebates will be limited to two per appliance, per mailing address. Purchases must be made from a Delaware retailer or online retailer. The State of Delaware reserves the right to inspect the participants' property to ensure that equipment was installed at the address given.
