

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE – PROGRAM CLOSED

Reservations began on April 16, 2010. As of April 19, Priority Numbers have been issued to individuals for all rebate funds allocated for the program, and funds are no longer available. PRODUCT	REQUIREMENTS	AMOUNT
Air Conditioners (Room)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.
Clothes Washers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.
Dishwashers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.
Freezers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.
Refrigerators	ENERGY STAR qualified.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.
Water Heaters (Gas Tankless)	ENERGY STAR qualified. Has an Energy Factor (EF) of at least 0.82.	20% of purchase price + \$75.* 20% of purchase price.

* Rebate amount is \$75 higher for each product with proof of recycling.

HOW TO APPLY

Information will be provided on the program Web site as it becomes available. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.

ELIGIBILITY

Must be a resident of Florida. Product must replace an existing appliance, and must be purchased from a retail establishment paying Florida taxes. Product must be intended for personal use in a home. Additional rebates are available if replaced appliances are recycled. Limit one rebate per product per household. Limit \$1,500 in rebates and recycling bonuses per household. Multi-tenant building owners or condo associations are not eligible.
