

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

AIR CONDITIONERS	Central	ENERGY STAR qualified. Split systems must have a Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) of at least 14.5, and an Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) of at least 12. Single-package equipment must have a SEER of at least 14, and an EER of at least 11.	\$150
	Room	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$100
Clothes Washers		ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$200
Freezers		ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$100
Refrigerators		ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$200

### HOW TO APPLY

Rebate applications will be available at participating retailers. Applications must include proof of eligible purchase and proof of recycling the replaced unit(s). Rebates will be issued to consumers 30 days after submitting an application packet. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a resident of Guam at least 18 year old or older, and provide a home address from the home Village Mayor's Office or a recent Guam Power Authority bill. Eligible new appliances must replace existing equipment. Limit one rebate per appliance category per household.
