

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED

Reservations began on April 22, 2010 and were all taken later the same day. Before making a purchase, confirm funding and requirements with the program sponsor in the HOW TO APPLY section.

PRODUCT	REQUIREMENTS	AMOUNT
Clothes Washers	Has a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of at least 2.0. Has a Water Factor (WF) of not more than 6.0.*	\$175
Dishwashers	Uses no more than 307 kWh per year. Uses no more than 5 gallons of water per cycle.*	\$250
Freezers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$50
Refrigerators	Annual kWh usage is at least 25% more efficient than the federal standard.*	\$200

*Exceeds current ENERGY STAR criteria.

HOW TO APPLY

Starting at 10 a.m. Eastern time on April 22, 2010, consumers can obtain a rebate authorization code through the 800 phone number or www.MassSave.com/Residential. Products must be purchased by May 12, 2010. Consumers' applications must be postmarked by June 26, 2010. Consumers should submit the application, complete with authorization number, a recent electric bill, and a sales receipt with manufacturer, make, model, and purchase date of the product. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis. This is a high volume program so please allow 8 weeks for delivery of the rebate check. 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ELIGIBILITY

Residents are eligible as long as the products are delivered to and hauled away from a Massachusetts address. Rebated products must replace an equivalent piece of equipment. Appliance must be purchased and delivered by a participating retailer. Product being replaced must be hauled away by the retailer. Limit one rebate per product per household.
