

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.



MISSOURI

Missouri Department of Natural Resources, Division of Energy

REBATES AVAILABLE

Rebates began April 19, 2010. Consumers may reserve a rebate through participating retailers or installation contractors at the point of purchase beginning at 8 a.m. on April 19, 2010. Beginning 9 a.m., April 21, 2010 and ending July 1, 2010, customers may reserve online via the program's Web site or via a toll-free phone number. Starting July 1, 2010 consumers may only apply for a rebate reservation through participating retailers or installation contractors at point-of-sale. Rebates for all products, except gas storage water heaters, closed on July 23, 2010. Rebates may be offered for a limited time only. The rebate program will end when funds run out. Air Conditioners (Central) (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR-qualified. Split systems must have a Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) of at least 14.5, and an Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) of at least 12. Single-package equipment must have a SEER of at least 14, and an EER of at least 11.	\$200
Clothes Washers (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR-qualified.	\$125
Dishwashers (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR-qualified.	\$125
Furnaces (Gas) (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR-qualified. Has an Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) of at least 90%.	\$250
Heat Pumps (Air-Source) (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR-qualified. Split systems must have a heating seasonal performance factor of at least 8.2, a Seasonal Energy Efficiency Ratio (SEER) of at least 14.5, and an Energy Efficiency Ratio (EER) of at least 12. Single-package equipment must have a heating seasonal performance factor of at least 8, a SEER of at least 14, and an EER of at least 11.	\$300

HOW TO APPLY

Consumers must reserve a rebate in one of three ways. 1) Consumers may reserve a rebate through participating retailers or installation contractors at the point of purchase beginning at 8 a.m. on April 19, 2010. 2) Online via the program's Web site beginning 9 a.m., April 21, 2010 and ending July 1, 2010. 3) Via a toll-free phone number beginning 9 a.m., April 21, 2010 and ending July 1, 2010. Consumers must apply for rebates within 60 days of making the initial reservation. Consumers must mail the rebate application form, proof of purchase, and recycling certification to the address printed on the rebate application form to receive a rebate for a new unit. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.

ELIGIBILITY

Must be a resident of Missouri 18 years of age or older. Must be the owner of the property for all appliances, with the exception of clothes washers. Renters are eligible for clothes washer rebates. Note that the rebate program does not apply to rental property owners or commercial enterprises, per U.S. Department of Energy guidelines. Product must be purchased from a retailer located in Missouri for residential use in an existing home. Product must be a replacement for a like item within each product category. All replaced appliances must be recycled. Please check with the participating retailer or contractor for recycling service. The purchaser may also turn in replaced appliances at an appliance collection center; purchaser must obtain a receipt from the recycler and submit it with the application. Limit one rebate per product type per household up to a maximum rebate amount of \$1,300. Consumers may be subject to an on-site visit to verify the purchases.
