

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE

Rebates began April 6, 2010. Rebate reservations closed on May 13, 2010, however, consumers can join a waitlist in the event additional funds become available. Rebates may be offered for a limited time only. The rebate program will end when funds run out. Before making a purchase, confirm funding and requirements with the program sponsor listed in the HOW TO APPLY section.

HOW TO APPLY

Rebates require advance reservations. Consumers must register online at the North Dakota rebate Web site, below, to receive a rebate form. Rebates will be issued to consumers on a first-come, first-served basis. Once the maximum number of rebates is made, the Web site will not allow consumers to register for a rebate form. Consumers must purchase the product and apply for rebates within 90 days of registration. Rebates will be issued as a prepaid debit card.

ELIGIBILITY

Consumer must be a resident of North Dakota. Product must be purchased from a qualified retailer in North Dakota. Old products must be picked up by a qualified retailer or taken to a qualified inert waste landfill by the consumer (consumer must provide disposal documentation). Limit one rebate per household.
