

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE

Rebates are scheduled to begin April 22, 2010. As of June 28, 2010, new applications for clothes washer and refrigerator rebates were no longer being accepted. Rebates may be offered for a limited time only. The rebate program will end when funds run out. Before making a purchase, confirm funding and requirements at www.e-rebates.org/nmarp.

PRODUCT	REQUIREMENTS	AMOUNT
Clothes Washers (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$200
Furnaces (Gas)	ENERGY STAR qualified. Has an Annual Fuel Utilization Efficiency (AFUE) of at least 90%.	\$200
Refrigerators (CLOSED)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$200

HOW TO APPLY

Applications must include proof of purchase, date of purchase, cost, make, and model of the purchased appliance. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first served basis. Additional information will be provided on the New Mexico rebate Web site as it becomes available.

ELIGIBILITY

Consumer must be a New Mexico resident. Qualified appliances must be purchased from retailers or contractors located in New Mexico, and must be installed in a New Mexico residence. Purchase must occur during the rebate period. Verification of installation may occur. Limit one rebate per product type per household. Landlords are not eligible for rebates.
