

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.



## NEW YORK

### REBATES AVAILABLE

**Under "New York's Great Appliance Swap Out" Rebate Program, rebates are available for eligible appliance purchases made between February 12 and the date available funding runs out. As of June 11, 2010, all of the available rebate funding was reserved, however, consumers can sign up on a waitlist in the event that additional funding becomes available. This is a first-come, first-served program. Once program funding is exhausted, applications will no longer be accepted. Two rebate options will be offered in this program. #### REBATE OPTION 2 – HIGH EFFICIENCY APPLIANCE BUNDLE

**To participate in the High Efficiency Appliance Bundle, consumers must purchase three High Efficiency ENERGY STAR appliances (a combination of a refrigerator, clothes washer and dishwasher) which must meet the efficiency requirements outlined in the table below:**

Clothes Washer	Has a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of at least 2.0. Has a Water Factor (WF) of not more than 6.0. (CEE Tier 2 or 3 <a href="http://www.cee1.org/resid/seha/rwsh/rwsh-prod.pdf">www.cee1.org/resid/seha/rwsh/rwsh-prod.pdf</a> ) **	\$555*
Dishwasher	Uses no more than 307 kWh per year. Uses no more than 5 gallons of water per cycle. (CEE Tier 1 or 2 <a href="http://www.cee1.org/resid/seha/dishw/dw-prod.pdf">www.cee1.org/resid/seha/dishw/dw-prod.pdf</a> ) **	
Refrigerator	Annual kWh usage is at least 25% more efficient than the federal standard. (Must be from CEE Tier 2 or 3 <a href="http://www.cee1.org/resid/seha/refrig/files/ref_prod.pdf">www.cee1.org/resid/seha/refrig/files/ref_prod.pdf</a> ) **	\$500

\*Rebate amount is higher with proof of recycling. \*\*Exceeds current ENERGY STAR criteria.

## HOW TO APPLY

Applicants must submit an application packet including an original sales receipt (showing make, model, price, and date of purchase of qualifying appliance) and proof of recycling (if applicable) for each appliance replaced. One application is required for each rebate desired. Consumers may apply for rebates online, but online applications will not be processed until original sales receipt and proof of recycling (if applicable) are received by mail. Consumers must mail their completed applications by July 31, 2010. Purchases must be made between February 12, 2010, and the date available funding runs out. Recycling receipt must be dated between February 12, 2010 and July 31, 2010.

Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis. Rebates will be issued to consumers four to six weeks after receipt of a complete application.

## ELIGIBILITY

Applicants must be residents of New York, and must attest that the appliance(s) being purchased replace existing appliance(s) of the same type. Appliances must be installed at a New York address. Eligible products must be purchased and recycled within published dates. For the Option 1 – Single Appliance Rebate, there is a limit of one rebate per product type per household; maximum three rebates per household. For the Option 2 – High Efficiency Appliance Bundle Rebate, only 1 bundle rebate is allowed per household.

Consumers are also eligible for a higher rebate with proof of recycling. The additional recycling rebates are: refrigerators, \$30; freezers, \$25; clothes washers, \$25; Higher Efficiency Home Appliance Package, \$55.

In addition to the above requirements, to participate in the Higher Efficiency Home Appliance Package Program, consumers must purchase three specific types of higher efficiency appliances.

Consumers who receive rebates under this state rebate program are not eligible for duplicate rebate programs offered by utilities.
