

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

HOW TO APPLY

Residents should check funding availability at www.RIRebates.com or by calling 1-877-359-5795. Residents are encouraged to purchase an eligible product before reserving the rebate on the program web site or toll free number. ENERGY STAR qualified product before applying for the rebate. The completed application and required materials must be mailed within 15 days of the online or phone reservation or application. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.
