

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED

Between December 20, 2010 and March 9, 2011, Texans could purchase appliances and participate in the Texas Appliance Mail-In Rebate Program. Rebates were offered for a limited time only; the program closed to new applications on Wednesday, March 9, 2011. An earlier rebate phase opened and closed in April 2010. HOW TO APPLY

To take advantage of the Texas Appliance Mail-in Rebate Program Texas consumers do not reserve funding for an appliance rebate. Rebates will be available on a first-come, first-served basis until all funds are distributed. Qualified purchases made on or after December 20, 2010 are eligible for a rebate. Rebates will be issued to consumers by check in the mail.

ELIGIBILITY

Products must be purchased from a retail establishment or through a Texas contractor that pays Texas taxes and must be purchased by a Texas resident for personal use. To qualify for the \$75 recycling rebate, consumers must provide proof of appliance pick up by or drop off to an organization (retailer, waste facility, etc.) that promises to recycle the old appliance according to federal and state laws. Consumers must also certify that the recycled appliance is functional and the same type and approximate size as the new product. Limit two new product rebates and two recycling rebates per product type per household.
