

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED

Rebates for dishwashers, freezers, air-source heat pumps, ground-source heat pumps, and gas tankless water heaters began February 1, 2010. Rebates for refrigerators and room air conditioners began November 22, 2010. Rebates for gas tankless water heaters ended November 22, 2010; all other rebates ended on November 30, 2011. PHASE 2: Began November 22, 2010.		
Air Conditioners (Room)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	30% of purchase price up to \$599.
Refrigerators	ENERGY STAR qualified.	30% of purchase price up to \$599.

*An additional \$100 rebate for recycling old units is available to residents of St. John, St. Thomas, and Water Island to defray transportation costs..

PHASE 1: Began February 1, 2010.

Water Heaters (Gas Tankless)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	30% of purchase price up to \$599.

HOW TO APPLY

Consumers must apply for rebates within 30 days of purchase. Rebates will be processed on a first-come, first-served basis, and will be issued to consumers within 30 to 60 days of receipt of complete application. Applications and more information will be available on the program Web site.

ELIGIBILITY

Consumers must be residents of the Virgin Islands (valid income tax documents or ID may be required as proof of residency). Consumers must be replacing an existing appliance to apply for rebates. Products must be purchased from a vendor in the U.S. Virgin Islands that possesses a retail business license. Products must be installed in the U.S. Virgin Islands. Recycling is required for the replaced air conditioners, dishwashers, freezers, and refrigerators; an additional \$100 recycling rebate is available to residents of St. John, St. Thomas, and Water Island to defray transportation costs. Limit one rebate per product per eligible household. Rebates are not available for government purchases or discretionary grant program grantees.
