

As part of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009, the U.S. Department of Energy is providing funding to states and territories to support consumer rebate programs for ENERGY STAR qualified appliances. Under these programs, consumers can receive rebates to purchase energy-efficient appliances when they replace used appliances. Eligibility guidelines, covered products, and rebate amounts differ by state, so consumers should review program requirements carefully.

REBATES AVAILABLE - PROGRAM CLOSED

Rebates began on June 17, 2010. Rebates for room air conditioners closed on September 16, 2010 and rebates for freezers closed on September 21, 2010; the waitlist for both of these products closed February 10, 2011. Air Conditioners (Room)	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$20
Clothes Washers	Has a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of at least 1.8. Has a Water Factor (WF) of not more than 7.5.*	\$50
	Has a Modified Energy Factor (MEF) of at least 2.0. Has a Water Factor (WF) of not more than 6.0.*	\$75
Dishwashers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$50
	Uses no more than 307 kWh per year. Uses no more than 5 gallons of water per cycle.*	\$75
Freezers	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$25
Refrigerators	ENERGY STAR qualified.	\$100

*Exceeds current ENERGY STAR criteria.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicant must be a West Virginia resident and meet all purchase and rebate program requirements. Rebates will be paid on a first-come, first-served basis.

ELIGIBILITY

Rebates are only available to West Virginia residents for non-commercial use. Qualifying ENERGY STAR appliances must be purchased within the State of West Virginia during appropriate dates as indicated by a copy of the purchase receipt from the retailer. Households are limited to one rebate per appliance category, with the exception of room air conditioners which had a category limit of five rebates.
